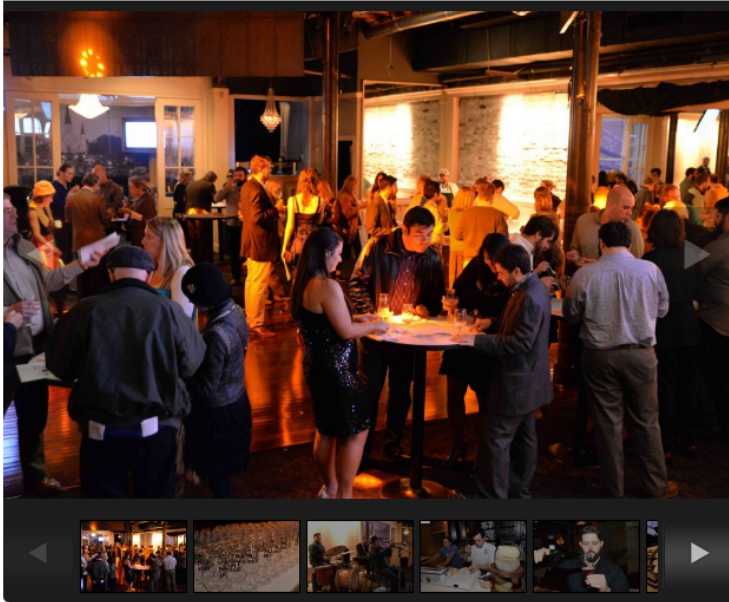


# A film by Anthony Bourdain, Belgian beer tasting and more New Orleans food events
